Consent for Participation

I give consent for to take part in the Keeping It Wild Youth Group Programme. There will be weekly evening meet ups with weekend commitments. I recognise that quality assurance procedures are in place to ensure that activities are well planned and appropriately risk assessed. Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust's vulnerable person protection policies are available on request.

I accept that the attendee must be well equipped to take part in the activities for which they register. This includes appropriate clothing were required. Any requirements will be communicated before the activity commences. I accept that the attendee may not be allowed to participate in the activity if the leader considers it unsafe or unwise.

Where possible Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust will provide transport to and from the activity location. The attendees may be asked to make their own way to designated pick-up/drop-off points. I understand that if transport provision is not possible, the attendee may be asked to make their own way to session locations, or be dropped-off or collected by designated adults at predetermined times.

I understand that the activity leader reserves the right to contact the designated adult and request that the attendee be removed from the activity or from the entire programme. This may be due to threatening or inappropriate behaviour, disruptive behaviour, or other reasons as the activity leader deems necessary.

I understand that the attendee may be using sharp tools and other equipment under the supervision of a qualified adult, and after receiving training.

I accept that in the event of illness or accident where the activity leader considers medical attention is needed, medical aid will be sought and all attempts to make contact with the designated adults will be made. I understand that in the event that no contact is possible it is the responsibility of a medical professional to decide whether treatment is necessary. I give consent that examination and treatment be provided as considered necessary by a medical professional or qualified First Aider.

Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust reserves the right to cancel any activity at any time. Every effort will be made to reschedule the event at a later date. In the event of cancellation I agree to collect the attendee at the earliest opportunity upon being contacted by the activity leader.
