is for Nottinghamshire’s people and wildlife to thrive. We value the environment and aim to engage and inspire at least 25% of our community to join us in dedicating 30% of land for wildlife and nature recovery across the county.

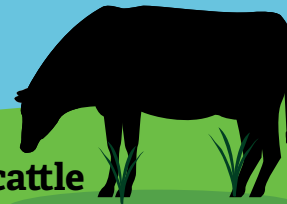
