Answer or 'signpost' queries about our reserve and wildlife work for visitors.

Be a central point of contact for the Idle Valley Nature Reserve staff team, its volunteers, site users and visitors

Approachable with a friendly personality Interested in wildlife and conservation. Like listening and helping people Ability to work as part of a team Efficient at taking messages and passing them on Some IT skills would be advantageous but not absolutely necessary
